

EQUIPMENT

The training school will provide suitable motorcycles, boots, helmets, gloves and body-armour. The remainder of the clothing will be the responsibility of the participants, but the training school does have moto-cross tops and trousers for hire or sale.



ACADEMIC ACCREDITATION

In addition to providing a very enjoyable, exciting and rewarding experience, the training school is able to accredit successful participants with a *Foundation Learning* Personal and Social Development qualification at Entry 3. For those completing all the tasks this will be at Award level.

COURSE TIMES

Each course consists of twelve two-hour sessions. These are usually delivered weekly, but the course could be delivered in a single block of four or five days which is a particularly suitable format for residential group visits (see Residential Courses).

ABOUT THE SCHOOL

The school only provides training as part of our extensive, structured teaching programme. All the sessions are a combination of explanation, demonstration, practice and assessment. Students progress at their own pace and only move from one element to the next when they have demonstrated competence and confidence. We believe that this policy gives our students the greatest opportunity to develop their skills in a safe environment and achieve their full potential.

ELIGIBILITY

Participants must be aged fourteen or over. Where possible we will provide alternative machinery to facilitate access to the course for those with disabilities or other special needs. No previous riding experience is necessary.

THE COURSE

Our aim is to provide our students with a course that gives them a thorough introduction to off-road riding. Each rider will start with the basics and then go as far as their skills, enthusiasm, knowledge and fitness (!) will take them. Throughout the course the importance of teamwork, self-discipline, setting and achieving goals and the responsibility for the safety of oneself and others will be stressed. Finally, we will always endeavour to meet these aims while ensuring that everyone enjoys every single minute of their experience!



COURSE GROUPS

The maximum number of candidates per course is eight. We will run courses for individuals to join on Saturdays and during school holidays throughout the year. Groups may book courses at any time during daylight hours.

RESIDENTIAL COURSES

We can offer overnight accommodation at a nearby local-authority-owned residential centre. The centre has dormitory-type rooms with catering provided as well as camping facilities and is open all year. Please contact us for rates and availability.



STAFF

Each course will be lead by an Auto-Cycle Union (ACU) qualified instructor who is also first-aid trained. There will always be two staff (CRB checked) on site.

INSURANCE

The school has £5 million Public Liability Insurance cover, but participants requiring personal accident cover are advised to make their own arrangements.
